

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is given that the Brush Country Groundwater Conservation District Board of Directors will hold a public hearing to receive public comment on its proposed desired future condition under Texas Water Code §§ 36.063(b) and 36.108(d-2) at its regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, June 23rd, 2026, at the Brush Country Groundwater Conservation District, located at 732 W. Rice Street, Falfurrias TX 78355. The public meeting will begin at 9:30 a.m. and the public hearing will take place during the public meeting and will begin about but no earlier than 9:35 a.m.
